Ingredients

- 4 large sweet white or purple onions
- 1/2 cup butter or olive oil
- salt and pepper to taste
- if desired, chopped fresh herbs such as basil, chives, oregano, rosemary, sage, and thyme

Directions

The Big Spring Clean



Spring cleaning isn't the absolute necessity it once was. In the days before electricity when fireplaces were used for heating and candles and oil lamps were used for lighting, soot and ash would build up on surfaces throughout the house. When the weather became warm enough to open the windows, the inside of the entire house was washed.

Although we don't have soot to wash off our walls nowadays, something about spring sunshine does make you see every dust-bunny and cobweb we seemed to have missed noticing all winter! Schedule a weekend for the "big clean" and recruit family members to help so that everything will get done faster.

What Makes This the "Big Clean?"

The Spring cleanup is the "Big Clean" because it's the time to take everything off shelves, tabletops and dressers to dust. It's also time to get to all the places you've been neglecting throughout the year, including ceiling fans, above kitchen cabinets, and baseboards and doorways. Move furniture away from walls and clean underneath. Vacuum seat cushions and sofa pillows (and don't forget to check for spare change underneath the cushions!). If your vacuum has an upholstery brush attachment, it can be used to vacuum dust from lampshades, draperies and even window screens.

Check for Damage

Since you are already seeing everything up close as you're cleaning, go ahead and look for things that need to be repaired while you're at it. In the bathroom and kitchen look for worn grout between floor tiles. A small crack in the grout or caulk can lead to an expensive repair later. If necessary, re-seal as soon as possible.

Look for peeling and chipping paint around window or door frames, which can indicate areas where moisture has come into the house. Seal any open areas between the frame and the wall to keep out water, which can deteriorate building materials. Look for stains on rugs and upholstered furniture and clean according to the care label.

Although all of this seems intimidating and a lot of hard work, in the end you and your family will breathe easier for it and have a healthier household! So crank up the tunes, pass out the dust-clothes and get to work!

of olive oil between the slices. Season with salt and pepper to taste, and fresh herbs, if desired. Close foil around onion. Repeat with remaining onions.

Set foil packets on the lower rack of a gas grill or directly on top of hot coals. Cook for about 30 to 35 minutes.

TIP: Put the packets on the grill when you light it. This will provide a good head start from the rest of your meal, giving the onions time to cook through and caramelize!
